



Your role

LEAD mentors are asked by the company (after the mentor matching event) to dedicate more time to meeting with them once a week or more. Each company has multiple lead mentors.

AD HOC mentors spend time with companies on an as-needed basis.

FRIENDS OF THE PROGRAM attend events and make connections when possible.


